

GENERAL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES



The standards of the school are apparent by the personal appearance of its staff and students. Styles that are extreme or that sacrifice decency, modesty, good taste, or Christian standards are not conducive to spiritual and academic growth. We must have an institutional standard to be consistent in our enforcement. Scriptural guidelines for students, staff, and volunteers to follow in reference to personal appearance are as follows:

- Modesty (I Timothy 2:9; II Timothy 2:22)
- Distinction between the sexes (Deuteronomy 22:5; I Corinthians 11:14 –15)
- In a manner pleasing to the Lord (I Timothy 4:12; Romans 12:1-2; I John 2:15-16)
- Appropriate dress for the occasion (I Corinthians 14: 40)

✓ The Administrator and School Board will have final discretion on subjective interpretation of the dress code and appearance policies. Note: If there are any questions concerning attire or appearance, call the school office prior to coming to school.

✓ The uniform dress code applies to all students and is in effect for all school days and NGCA after-school sponsored activities, including field trips, sporting events, and ceremonies. **We respectfully ask that you follow casual dress day guidelines for any school-sponsored function including all athletic events.**

- Uniforms purchased from other retail stores must be the same colors and styles as offered from Land's End. Not all retail uniform shop clothing styles are approved for NGCA.
- Uniforms should be appropriately sized (not too large, too small, tight, or too short) for the student.
- Pants, shorts, skirts may be purchased from other retail stores if they are the same color, style, and length.
- **All uniform shirts, blouses, sweaters, solid dresses, and jackets must be ordered from Land's End and be monogrammed with the school name/logo.**
- School colors for polo tops: Hunter Green, Navy Blue, Maize Yellow, Light Blue, Gray, and White
- School colors for bottoms: Navy, Khaki, Gray, and Land's End White Plaid (skirts, shorts, and jumpers)



Fieldtrip Attire Policy

All students are required to wear the school issued fieldtrip shirt on all fieldtrips unless they are given specific dress guidelines by supervising teachers. Students should wear fieldtrip shirts and any approved casual dress day bottoms and shoes.
